Chapter 120

AN ACT to Classify Certain Minor Tributaries of the Androscoggin River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 38, § 368, amended. Subsection I of that part of section 368 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, under the caption Androscoggin River Basin Minor Tributaries, Androscoggin River, is amended to read as follows:
- 1. All tributaries, direct and indirect of the Androscoggin River, lying wholly within the State of Maine, not otherwise specified or classified with the following exceptions: Little Androscoggin River, Logan Brook, Penley Brook and No Name Brook in Lewiston Class B-1.
 - A. No Name Brook (Lewiston) Class C.
 - B. Logan Brook (Auburn) Class C.
 - C. Penley Brook (Auburn) Class C.

Effective October 1, 1969

Chapter 121

AN ACT to Classify Certain Tidal Waters of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 38, § 370, amended. Paragraph B of subsection 6, Deer Isle, of that part of section 370 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, under the caption Hancock County is amended to read as follows:
 - B. Tidewater of Blastrow Cove in Little Deer Isle—Class SC SB-2.
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 38, § 370, amended. Subsection 17, Stonington, of that part of section 370 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes under the caption Hancock County is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
 - 17. Stonington.
 - A. Tidewater from the Moose Island Bridge to Ames Pond outlet including waters of Moose Island Class SB-2.
 - B. Tidewaters within the Town of Stonington not otherwise specified or classified Class SB-1.
