Chapter 35

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Strong for Support of Evangeline C. Bean.

Town of Strong; reimbursed. Resolved: There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,602.78 to be paid to the Town of Strong to reimburse the town for support furnished Evangeline C. Bean.

Chapter 36

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Bernard J. Kinney of Winthrop for Well Damage by Highway Maintenance.

Bernard J. Kinney; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,200 to be paid to Bernard J. Kinney of Winthrop for salt damage to his well caused by maintenance on Route No. 133 in Winthrop.
