Chapter 56

RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Copies of History of Auburn.

History of Auburn; purchase of. Resolved: That on the occasion of the City of Auburn's centennial there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 for the State to purchase 100 copies of the book "History of Auburn"; said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

Chapter 57

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Julia Junkins of South Portland for Damage to Property.

Mrs. Julia Junkins; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the sum of \$500, to Mrs. Julia Junkins, of South Portland for damage to her property incurred by an escapee from the Boys Training Center.

Chapter 58

RESOLVE, Reimbursing the Town of Sullivan for Winter Road Maintenance.

Town of Sullivan; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated to the Town of Sullivan, Hancock County, the sum of \$1,243.45 from the General Highway Fund as a full and final settlement for winter road maintenance for the winter of 1964-65.
