Chapter 62

RESOLVE, To Reimburse Warren F. Chapman of Skowhegan for Well Damage by Highway Maintenance.

Warren F. Chapman; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,200 to be paid to Warren F. Chapman of Skowhegan for salt damage to his well, caused by highway maintenance on Route No. 201 in Skowhegan.

Effective October 1, 1969

Chapter 63

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Elmer L. Rogers of Berwick for Well Damage by Highway Construction.

Elmer L. Rogers; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$675 to be paid to Elmer L. Rogers of Berwick for damage to his well caused by highway construction.
