Chapter 65

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Doris Nankervis of Franklin for Well Damage by Highway Maintenance.

Doris Nankervis; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$800 to be paid to Doris Nankervis of Franklin for salt damage to her well caused by maintenance on Route No. 182 in Franklin.

Effective October 1, 1969

Chapter 66

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Walter Ware of Benton for Well Damage by Highway Maintenance.

Walter Ware; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$765 to be paid to Walter Ware of Benton for salt damage to his well caused by maintenance of highway in Benton.

Effective October 1, 1969

Chapter 67

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Norman E. Dudley of Waite for Well Damage Caused by Road Construction and Highway Maintenance.

Norman E. Dudley; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$675, to be paid to Norman E. Dudley of Waite for salt damage to his well caused by maintenance on Route 1 in Waite.
