Chapter 6

AN ACT Relating to Property, Capital Stock and Indebtedness of Eastport Water Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1887, c. 22, § 2, repealed and replaced. Section 2 of chapter 22 of the private and special laws of 1887, as amended by section 4 of chapter 10 of the private and special laws of 1913, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Section 2. Property. The Eastport Water Company may hold real and personal property, necessary and convenient for the purposes aforesaid.

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1887, c. 22, § 5, repealed and replaced. Section 5 of chapter 22 of the private and special laws of 1887, as amended by section 5 of chapter 10 of the private and special laws of 1913, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Section 5. Capital stock. The capital stock of said company shall be \$100,000 which may be increased or diminished at any time, subject to the general laws and the approval of the Public Utilities Commission.

Sec. 3. P. & S. L., 1887, c. 22, § 10, repealed and replaced. Section 10 of chapter 22 of the private and special laws of 1887 as last amended by section 1 of chapter 10 of the private and special laws of 1913, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Section 10. Indebtedness. Said corporation may from time to time issue such bonds, debentures or other evidence of indebtedness, subject to the general laws and the approval of the Public Utilities Commission.

Chapter 7

AN ACT Relating to Time of Annual Meeting of Mount Desert Island Regional School District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1963, c. 176, § 11, amended. The first sentence of section 11 of chapter 176 of the private and special laws of 1963, is amended to read as follows:

The annual meeting of the district shall be held within the district, and at the school building when completed, on the ~~3rd Monday~~ **2nd Wednesday** of February, such meeting to start between 9 o'clock in the forenoon and 8 o'clock in the afternoon.
