Chapter 43

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Mrs. Edward L. Libby of Kennebunk for Displacement Costs Because of Property Taken by State.

Mrs. Edward L. Libby; reimbursement. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Mrs. Edward L. Libby of Kennebunk the sum of \$1,200 to reimburse her for displacement and moving costs in connection with property taken in the construction of I-295 in Portland.

RESOLVE, Reimbursing Donald F. Bartlett for Damage Due to Highway Maintenance.

Donald F. Bartlett; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Donald F. Bartlett of Hallowell the sum of \$341.60 for damage to his driveway due to highway maintenance.

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Ripley & Fletcher Co. of South Paris for Gasoline Shrinkage.

Ripley & Fletcher Co.; appropriation for. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$474.90 to reimburse Ripley & Fletcher Co. of South Paris to cover loss of gasoline through shrinkage.
