CHAPTER 119

AN ACT Concerning Revocation of Certain Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2401-B, sub-§ 16, ¶ I is enacted to read:

I. Revocation by commissioner. The commissioner may revoke, without refund, any resident license, if the licensee fails to furnish proof of residence within 14 days of written request. Such request shall be made to the address shown on the license.

CHAPTER 120

AN ACT Relating to Dogs Running at Large.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

7 MRSA § 3457, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 45, § 1, is amended to read:

§ 3457. Penalties

~~Instead of~~ In addition to seizing and impounding the dog, the officer, having jurisdiction, may prosecute the owner of any dog running at large, and
