complaint issuing out of the Superior Court under the authority of this resolve shall be served upon the State as provided by, the Maine Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 4. The Attorney General is authorized and designated to appear, answer and defend the action.

Any judgment that may be recovered in this civil action shall be payable from the State Treasury on final process issued by the Superior Court or, if there is an appeal, the Supreme Judicial Court, and costs may be taxed for Beverly Mortimer and Dennis Perkins if they recover in the action. Any recovery against the State in that action shall not exceed \$100,000, including costs. Hearing thereon shall be before a Justice of the Superior Court with or without a jury.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall become effective when approved.

## CHAPTER 88

### RESOLVE, to Appeal the Decision of State Claims Board Regarding Property Damage Claims from Collapse of Building at Northern Maine Vocational-Technical Institute.

**Claims appeal to the Legislature. Resolved:** That the decision of the State Claims Board be appealed to the Legislature pursuant to the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1510, subsection 1; and be it further

**Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$4,132.84 to reimburse the following persons in the amounts indicated as a full and final settlement of their claims for property damage against the State due to the collapse of a building at Northern Maine Vocational-Technical Institute:
