## CHAPTER 189

S. P. 426 — L.D. 1295

### AN ACT to Revise the Fees for the Licensing of Psychologists.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA § 3833, 1st sentence, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 186, is further amended to read:

There shall be paid to the board chairman by each applicant for a permanent license a fee of \$50 for the initial application and a fee of ~~\$50~~ **an amount not to exceed \$75** for the examination.

Sec. 2. 32 MRSA § 3835, 1st sentence, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 767, § 45, is further amended to read:

The board shall have authority to adopt and enforce rules and regulations ~~requiring to require~~ every person having a license to practice, which is granted by ~~that the board to pay a biennial registration renewal fee of \$20~~ **\$40**.

## CHAPTER 190

H. P. 762 — L. D. 942

### AN ACT to Exempt from Sales Taxes Depreciable Machinery Used in Commercial Farming and Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 2013, sub-§ 3 is enacted to read:

3. **Exemption for large purchase after certification. No sales tax shall be paid**
