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CHAPTER 304

H. P. 957 — L. D. 1187

AN ACT to Amend the Authority Granted to Municipalities to Enact Police Power Ordinances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2151, sub-§ 4, ¶ C, sub-¶ (1) is amended to read:

(1) The provisions pertaining to buildings apply equally to all structures including wharves, piers and pilings and parts of them.

CHAPTER 305

H. P. 815 — L. D. 1017

AN ACT to Ensure Firefighters may use a Reasonable Degree of Nondeadly Force to Carry Out their Firefighting Duties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 3774, sub-§ 1, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 680, § 5, is amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read:

A firefighter is authorized to use a reasonable degree of nondeadly force when he reasonably believes that this force is necessary to carry out his duties under this subsection.

AN ACT to Partially Exempt Musicians from Coverage for Unemployment Insurance.
