CHAPTER 333

H. P. 745 — L. D. 931

AN ACT to Provide for an Official Seal for the Department of Human Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 1, first ¶ as last amended by PL 1975, c. 293, § 1, is further amended by adding a new sentence after the 2nd sentence to read:

The department shall have an official department seal, which shall be judicially noticed.

CHAPTER 334

S. P. 319 — L. D. 949

AN ACT to Allow Unions to Negotiate on Behalf of Former Employees of a Company with Which the Union is Negotiating.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

26 MRSA § 9 is enacted to read:

§ 9. Negotiations on behalf of retired employees

Employee organizations, unions and bargaining agents in the private sector engaged in collective bargaining with employers may negotiate on behalf of retired and retired disabled former employees of the employer with respect to pensions, retirement benefits and other benefits which, as a part of wages and benefits related to employment, are, were or may be carried with retired employees into retirement.
