CHAPTER 215

H.P. 167 - L.D. 198

AN ACT to Prohibit Shooting within 100 Yards of any Dwelling During Hunting Season.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- 12 MRSA $\S7406$, sub- $\S13$, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, $\S1$, is amended to read:
- 13. Discharging firearm near dwelling. A Unless a relevant municipal ordinance provides otherwise and except as provided in section 7501 and 7502, a person is guilty of discharging a firearm near a dwelling if he discharges a firearm within 100 feet yards of a residential dwelling without the permission of the owner or, in his absence, of an adult occupant of that dwelling. Nothing in this subsection may be construed to prohibit a person from killing or taking a wild animal in accordance with sections 7501 and 7502.

CHAPTER 216

H.P. 716 - L.D. 907

AN ACT to Eliminate Reports by District Attorneys to the Attorney General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

30 MRSA §505, as amended by PL 1977, c. 696, §222, is repealed.
