CHAPTER 249

H.P. 591 - L.D. 735

**AN ACT to Amend the Termination of Parental
Rights Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §4052, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 733, §18, is amended to read:

2. Time filed. A termination petition may be brought no earlier than 3 months after disposition under section 4036 or under Title 19, section 213, 214 or 752.

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §4055, sub-§1, ¶A, as repealed and replaced by PL 1981, c. 369, §15, is amended to read:

A. One of the following conditions has been met:

(1) Custody has been removed from the parent under:

(a) Section 4035 or 4038;

(b) Title 19, section 213, 214 or 752;
or

(c) Section 3792 prior to the effective date of this chapter; or

(2) The petition has been filed as part of an adoption proceeding in Title 19, chapter 9; and

Effective September 23, 1983.

H.P. 636 - L.D. 787

AN ACT to Regulate Striped Bass Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
