#### CHAPTER 332

H.P. 750 - L.D. 962

AN ACT to Authorize the Maine Turnpike Authority to Receive Applications and Approve Descriptive and Directional Signs on the Maine Turnpike.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

23 MRSA §1201, as amended by PL 1981, c. 613, is further amended by adding after the first  $\P$  a new paragraph to read:

The Maine Turnpike Authority shall develop guidelines for review of applications from organizations requesting signs on the Maine Turnpike, directing motorists to structures and objects of local, regional and statewide interest. Authority for approval of applications for directional signs rests with the Maine Turnpike Authority.

Effective September 23, 1983.

#### CHAPTER 333

H.P. 1115 - L.D. 1473

AN ACT Repealing the Law on the Effect of Bail Following Conviction and Commitment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

15 MRSA §1701, as repealed and replaced by PL 1965, c. 356, §54, is repealed.

H.P. 1183 - L.D. 1576

AN ACT to Suspend Operation Authority on Motor Vehicles which Fail to Comply with the Gasoline Reporting Law.
