CHAPTER 350

S.P. 492 - L.D. 1491

AN ACT Relating to Forged or Illegal Prescriptions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- 17-A MRSA §1108, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 512, §33, is amended to read:
 - 4. Acquiring drugs by deception is:
 - A. A Class C crime if the drug is a schedule $W_{\underline{\mathcal{X}}}$ or $\underline{\mathcal{Y}}$ drug; or
 - B. A Class D crime if the drug is a schedule X_7 Y or Z drug.

CHAPTER 351

S.P. 333 - L.D. 978

AN ACT to Clarify the Administration of the Department of Labor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 2 MRSA §6, sub-§5, as repealed and replaced by PL 1981, c. 705, Pt. L, §§1-3, is amended to read:
- 5. Range 86. The salaries of the following state officials and employees shall be within the salary range 86:

Director of Labor Standards;

Deputy Chief of the State Police;

Director of State Lotteries;

State Archivist;

Director of Maine Geological Survey;
