34-A MRSA §5807, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 459, §6, is amended to read:

§5807. Sentence for crime committed by parolee

Any parolee who commits an offense while on parole where the offense is punishable by imprisonment for one year or more and who is sentenced to the Maine State Prison Department of Corrections shall serve the 2nd sentence beginning on the date of termination of the first sentence, unless the first sentence is otherwise terminated by the board.

CHAPTER 204

S.P. 552 - L.D. 1470

AN ACT to Establish a Funding Mechanism to
Make the Joint Environmental Training
Program Self-supporting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

32 MRSA §4173-A, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 832, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

3. Self supporting. This program shall be self-supporting from fees, grants or other sources of revenue not including the General Fund.
