Sen. Pray notified members that the Council would meet the next day (Wednesday, June 12) to consider proposed studies, noting that the Council's primary focus was on the funding and legislative staff requirements. Speaker Martin noted that his Legal Counsel. Jon Hull, had identified several study bills that raised policy issues, the foremost being the funding mechanism. Due to the budget situation, committees have sought other means to fund studies than a General Fund appropriation; however, some of these raise potential conflict issues which need to be looked at more carefully. These bills have subsequently been tabled in the House.
