SENATE

Tuesday, January 25, 1972

Senate called to order by the Secretary.

Prayer by the Rev. David Dunn of Augusta.

On motion by Mr. Hoffses of Knox, Senator Richard N. Berry was unanimously elected President pro tem for today's session and was escorted to the rostrum by the Sergeant-at-Arms where he assumed the duties of that office.

Joint Order

Out of order and under suspension of the rules, on motion by Mr. Sewall of Penobscot:

ORDERED, the House concurring, that unless received by unanimous consent in both branches, no bill or resolve be considered at this Special Session except those designated Legislative Documents Nos. 1867 to 2019 inclusive, and such bills or resolves as may be returned by or recalled from the Governor. This Order shall not apply to such bills or resolves as are intended only to facilitate the business of the Special Session. (S. P. 730)

Non-concurrent Matter**

Resolve, to Reimburse Certain Persons for Displacement Costs Because of Property Taken by State. (S. P. 691) (L. D. 1872)

In the Senate January 24, 1972, referred to the Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.

Comes from the House, referred to the Committee on Legal Affairs, in non-concurrence.

Thereupon, the Senate voted to Recede and Concur.

Joint Order

ORDERED, WHEREAS, the Legislature has learned that Mrs. Kathryn C. Douglas has been stricken with a serious illness; and

ORDERED, the Senate concurring, that we, the Members of the Senate and House of Representatives of the One Hundred and Fifth Legislature, acknowledge with deep concern the illness of our dear friend and former fellow worker and express our faith, hope and prayer for her recovery; and be it further

ORDERED, that a suitable copy of this Order properly attested be immediately transmitted to her at the Waterville Osteopathic Hospital to convey the sentiments expressed herein. (H. P. 1553)
