Augusta, Maine June 18, 1983

Senate called to order by the President.

Prayer by The Honorable Charles P. Pray of Penobscot.

Senator PRAY: Let us pray. As we come to the final days of this Session, let us remember who we are here to serve, the people of the State of Maine. Let us do their will. Amen.

Senator Pearson of Penobscot was granted unanimous consent to address the Senate, On the Record.

Senator PEARSON: Mr. President and Men and Women of the Senate yesterday afternoon, at noon, I was present for the signing of the Rivers Bill which is in my opinion one of the major steps to improve and keep Maine's environment in good condition, and it reminded me of Senator Donald Twitchell of Oxford County. He has been before the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources with a Bill dealing with the clean up of a hazardous waste site in Buckfield and I think that the people of Oxford County should be aware of the fact that he has been an aggressive Senator and should be proud of the efforts that he has made in that regard.
