Dear Mr. Speaker and Mr. President:

In accordance with Title 5, Maine Revised Statutes Annotated, Section 1547, the accompanying Financial Report of the State of Maine is submitted for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1992. The first section of the report consists of the General Purpose Financial Statements for all funds reported in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. Generally accepted accounting principles for the Governmental Funds uses the modified accrual basis of accounting. Revenues are recognized when they become measurable and available as current assets. Expenditures are generally recognized when the related fund liability is incurred. Exceptions to generally accepted accounting principles in these financial statements include accumulated unpaid vacation and sick leave which has not been recorded, and interest on general long-term debt which is recognized when due.

The second section is reported as it has been in the past, based upon the budgetary and legal requirements. Please refer to Note 7 of the General Notes to the Financial Statements for the reconciliation of the fund balances between the two sections. Comparative budgetary data and statistical information have also been included in this report to promote a better understanding of the State's finances.

Questions and comments about this report or any phase of State finances are always welcome.
