## STATE OF MAINE PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, there exists in the State of Maine an extraordinary occasion arising out of the need to resolve many legislative matters pending at the time of the adjournment of the Second Legislative Session of the 121<sup>st</sup> Legislature of the State of Maine; and

WHEREAS, the public health, safety and welfare requires that the Legislature resolve these pending matters as soon as possible, and in any event prior to the date of the First Regular Session of the 122<sup>nd</sup> Legislature of the State of Maine, including but not limited to pending legislation and pending nominations of state board and commission members by the Governor requiring legislative confirmation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN ELIAS BALDACCI, Governor of the State of Maine, by virtue of the constitutional power vested in me as Governor pursuant to Article V, Part 1, section 13 of the Constitution of the State of Maine, convene the Legislature of this State, hereby requesting the Senators and Representatives to

assemble in their respective chambers at the Capitol in Augusta on Tuesday, February 3, 2004, at 10:00 in the morning, in order to receive communications, resolve pending legislation carried over from the Second Regular Session of the 121<sup>st</sup> Legislature and act upon pending nominations.

In testimony whereof, I have caused the Great Seal of the State to be hereunto Affixed GIVEN under my hand at Augusta this thirtieth day of January in the Year Two Thousand and Four.
