Papers from the House disposed of in concurrence.

Bill an act to amend sub-division VII of paragraph 1, of chapter 18, of the laws of 1895, relative to fire insurance, came from the House referred to the committee on legal affairs. motion by Mr. Whitehouse of Sagadahoc, the Senate non-concurred in reference, and referred the bill to the committee on mercantile affairs and insur-

A communication was received from the secretary of State, transmitting the report of the Maine State prison, and was referred to the committee on State prison.

A communication was received from the secretary of State transmitting the report of the commissioners of sea and shore fisheries for 1898, and was referred to the committee on sea and shore fisheries.

The following bills, petitions, were presented and referred:

JUDICIARY.

By. Mr. Chamberlain of Lincoln-Bill an act to authorize the construction of a dam at the mill pond at New Harbor in Bristol.

Petition of Lyman W. Hanna and 48 others, for the same.

LEGAL AFFAIRS.

By Mr. Witham of Cumberland-Petition of T. H. Jackson and 49 others of Sebago, praying for an amendment to chapter 329, of the laws of 1897, relating to road commissioners.

By Mr. Reynolds of Cumberland-Bill an act for the better protection of shipmasters and seamen.

By Mr. Blanchard of Franklin-Petition of I. W. Sargent and 100 others for change in the law relative to election of road commissioner.

RAILROADS, TELEGRAPHS AND EXPRESSES.

By Mr. Reynolds of Cumberland-Petition of Fred Emery Beane and 100 others, urging the passage of an act regarding electric railway companies to run and use vestibule cars.

BANKS AND BANKING.

By Mr. Vickery of Kennebec-Bill an act to amend the charter of the Augusta Safe Deposit and Trust Co.

By Mr. Hargraves of York-Petition of Wm. J. Maybury and others for an act to establish the York County Trust Co., with act therefor.

READ AND ASSIGNED.

Resolve for the purpose of operating fish hatcheries and feeding stations for fish and for the proper enforcement of the inland fish and game laws.

Bill an act to amend the charter of the Maine Charitable Mechanic Association.

Bill an act to amend chapter 203, of the Public Laws of 1893, relating to the education of the deaf, dumb and blind.

Resolve to provide means for the examination of claims for State pensions.
