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**SENATE.**

Friday, Jan. 27.

Senate met according to adjournment.

Prayer by Rev. Mr. Peckham of Lowell.

Journal read and approved.

House papers disposed of in concurrence.

The following House bill was read and assigned:

Bill an act to amend sections 2, 7 and 13 of chapter 180 of the Private and Special Laws of 1869 relating to parishes of the Protestant Episcopal church.

The following bills and petitions were presented and referred:

**LEGAL AFFAIRS.**

By Mr. Blanchard of Franklin—Bill an act relating to foreigners not naturalized.

**EDUCATION.**

By Mr. Blanchard of Franklin—Bill an act for the maintenance of a free high school in towns having a population of 1000 or more.

**INLAND FISHERIES AND GAME.**

By Mr. Vickery of Kennebec—Petition of G. S. Perkins and others of Sidney, for repeal of close time on deer in Kennebec county.

**OXFORD COUNTY DELEGATION.**

By Mr. King of Oxford—Petition of Geo. A. Wilson and others to increase the salary of the register of probate in Oxford county.

**ORDERS.**

On motion by Mr. Adams of Penobscot, it was

This order was sent to the House and subsequently returned passed in concurrence.

**READ AND ASSIGNED.**

An act to extend the charter of the Waldoboro Water and Electric Light and Power Co.

An act amendatory of and additional to chapter 458 of the Private and Special Laws of 1897 entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Northern Development Co."

An act in relation to the school committee of the city of Portland.

**TABLED.**

The following came up for its first reading and on motion by Mr. Adams of

Penobscot, was tabled pending first reading:

'An Act to amend section 1 of chapter 350 of the Private and Special Laws of 1897 relating to the erection and maintenance of booms in the Penobscot river.

**REPORT OF COMMITTEES.**

The committee on public buildings to which was referred the order of the Legislature relating to assignment of rooms in the State House to the secretary of the Senate and clerk of the House, reported accompanying order and that further action at the present time on said order is inexpedient.

Ordered, That the secretary of the Senate be assigned room No. 120 in the State House and that the superintendent of public buildings be directed to furnish said room suitable for that purpose.

On motion by Mr. Vickery of Kennebec, the report with accompanying order was laid on the table and Tuesday, Jan. 31, assigned for further consideration.

**PASSED TO BE ENACTED.**

An act to amend section 54 of chapter 51, R. S., relating to assignment of charter or rights under it by railroad corporations.
