SENATE

Tuesday, January 8, 1935 Senate called to order by the President.

Prayer by the Rev. L. D. Porter of Gardiner.

Journal of Thursday, January 3, read and approved.

Mr. WINN of Androscoggin: Mr. President, it is with deep personal sorrow that I announce to you and to the Senate the death of the esteemed senator-elect, Elwood P. Weeks of Androscoggin, whose un-timely passing occurred before he had assumed his seat. And I move that the President of the Senate be requested to extend the sympathy of this body to the afflicted family.
