Dear Sir:

Will you kindly convey to the House of Representatives the information that I have been elected to the office of Attorney General and have qualified for that position, and that I did not qualify, nor take my seat, as a member of the House of Representatives in the Ninetieth Legislature.

Inasmuch as the position of Attorney General and that of Representative to the Legislature are incompatible under the Constitution, my qualifying for the office of Attorney General has automatically disqualified me from serving with you in the present Legislature. The seat in the Ninetieth Legislature to which I was elected is, therefore, vacant.

Mr. Payson of Portland, presented the following Order, out of order, and moved its passage:

ORDERED, the Senate concurring that there be paid to the members of the Senate and House as advances on account of compensation established by statute, the amount of seventy dollars (\$70.) fortnightly, according to lists certified to the State Controller by the

Secretary of the Senate and Clerk of the House respectively; and that the final pay rolls bear the approval of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.
