Thursday, January 15, 1942.

The Senate was called to order by the President.

Prayer by the Reverend Andrew T. McWhorter of Augusta.

Journal of yesterday read and approved.

The PRESIDENT: Is there any business to come before the Senate?

Thereupon, on motion by Mr. Elliot of Knox the Senate voted to take from the table Memorial in re Defense Savings Bonds and

Stamps (S. P. 586), tabled yesterday by that Senator pending consideration; and that Senator yielded to the Senator from Washington, Senator Chase.

On motion by Mr. Chase of Washington the Senate voted to recede and concur with the House in placing the memorial on file.

The PRESIDENT: Is there any further business to come before the Senate at this time?

Thereupon, on motion by Mr. Elliot of Knox

Adjourned until tomorrow at twelve o'clock noon.
