Tuesday, April 18, 1944 The Senate was called to order by the President.

Orders of the Day Order (Out of Order)

On motion by Mr. Elliot of Knox, it was

ORDERED, that William S. Sewall of Liberty be appointed to serve as Page for this Special Session.

On motion by Mr. Elliot of Knox, the Senate voted to take from the table Joint Order (S. P. 504) relative to introduction of bills, tabled by that Senator on April 17 pending

passage; and on further motion by the same Senator, the Order receiv-ed passage and was sent to the House forthwith for concurrence.

On motion by Mr. Elliot of Knox, Recessed until this afternoon at five o'clock.

After Recess

The Senate was called to order by the President.

Order

(Out of Order) On motion by Mr. Hanold of Cumberland, out of order and under suspension of the rules, it was

ORDERED, the House concurring, that there be paid to the officers of the Senate and House of Representatives for mileage, the amounts included in lists certified to by the State Controller by the Secretary of the Senate and Clerk of the House, respectively. (S. P. 508)

Sent down for concurrence.

Subsequently the foregoing order was returned from the House hav-ing been read and passed in concurrence.

Passed to be Enacted

Bill "An Act Accepting from Per-cival Proctor Baxter the convey-ance and Deed of Gift of twentyfour thousand six hundred and eighty-two (24,682) acres of land in township five (5) range ten (10) W.E.L.S. Piscataquis County, BAX-TER STATE PARK. (S. P. 500) (L. D. 477)

On motion by Mr. Elliot of Knox, Adjourned until tomorrow morning at ten o'clock.
