HOUSE

Wednesday, July 17, 1946.

The House met according to adjournment and was called to order by the Speaker.

Prayer by the Rev. Mr. Sanford of Farmingdale.

Journal of the previous session read and approved.

Orders

On motion by Mr. Ward of Millinocket, it was

ORDERED, that Mr. Christensen of Calais and Mr. Palmetoer of Charlotte be excused from attendance because of serious injuries suffered in an automobile accident; that the Clerk of the House be directed to send flowers and express to them the hope of the members for their speedy and complete recovery.

On motion by Mr. Lord of Camden, it was

ORDERED, that Mrs. Ellingwood of Rockland be excused from attendance this week because of illness.

Ought Not to Pass

Mr. Rankin from the Committee on Legal Affairs reported "Ought not to pass" on Bill "An Act Increasing the Borrowing Capacity of the town of Norridgewock School District" (H. P. 1494) (L. D. 1201)

Report was read and accepted and sent up for concurrence.

Ought to Pass

Mr. Payson from the Committee on Legal Affairs reported "Ought to pass" on Bill "An Act Amending the Charter of the city of Portland" (H. P. 1496) (L. D. 1203)

Report was read and accepted and the Bill having already been printed, was read twice under suspension of the rules and tomorrow assigned.

Ought to Pass With Committee Amendment

Mr. Snow from the Committee on Legal Affairs on Bill "An Act to Incorporate the North Haven Port District" (H. P. 1495) (L. D. 1202) reported "Ought to pass" as amended by Committee Amendment "A" submitted therewith.

Report was read and accepted and the Bill having already been printed, was read twice under suspension of the rules.

Committee Amendment "A" was read by the Clerk as follows:

Committee Amendment "A" to H. P. 1495, L. D. 1202, Bill "An Act to Incorporate the North Haven Port District."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the 1st sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 3 thereof a new sentence to read as follows:

"Such trustees shall be residents of the town of North Haven and shall hold no municipal office in such town."

Committee Amendment "A" was adopted and the bill was assigned for third reading tomorrow morning.

The following Order was received from the Senate, out of order and under suspension of the rules:

ORDERED, the House concurring, that the Secretary of the Senate and Clerk of the House be authorized and directed to have printed all new drafts that may accompany reports of committees forthwith after such reports are filed in their respective offices. (S. P. 477)
