Saturday, July 20, 1946

Prayer by the Reverend Douglas N. Robbins of Augusta.

Journal of yesterday read and approved.

Orders of the Day

Mr. SAVAGE of Somerset: Mr. President, I would like to inquire if House Paper 513, Legislative Document 1246, is in the possession of the Senate.

The PRESIDENT: The Chair will state that the document, being an Act Providing for Construction of Dormitories for the University of Maine and Appropriating Money Therefor, is in the possession of the

Senate, being held pending reconsideration.

Mr. SAVAGE: Mr. President, I move you, sir, that we reconsider our action of yesterday whereby we passed this bill to be engrossed.

The PRESIDENT: The Senator from Somerset, Senator Savage, moves that the Senate reconsider its action of yesterday, whereby the bill was passed to be engrossed.

Mr. SAVAGE: I now move you, sir, that the bill be laid upon the table.

Thereupon, the bill was laid upon the table pending motion to reconsider and was especially assigned Monday, July 22nd.
