Resolution, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine Clarifying Residency Requirements for Candidates for and Members of the Maine House of Representatives. Presented by Rep. Masterton of Cape Elizabeth. State Government Hearing 2-9-81. OTP-AM Accepted. Amended by: CA H-47. Finally Passed, CON RES LAWS, Chapt. 2. Approved in Referendum 11-3-81 (In favor: 193,862; Opposed: 37,257).
