RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Insure the Preservation of the Right to Keep and Bear Arms. Presented by Rep. Martin of Eagle Lake; Cosponsored by Rep. Duffy of Bangor, Rep. Ruhlin of Brewer, and Sen. Pray of Penobscot. State and Local Government Hearing 04/15/87. OTP-AM Accepted 06/03/87. Amended by: CA H-230. Finally Passed, CON RES LAWS, Chapter 2. Approved in Referendum, 11/03/87 (In favor: 216,013; Opposed: 159,226).
