RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Protect Revenues Raised By the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Presented by Rep. Jacques of Waterville; Co-sponsored by Sen. Pearson of Penobscot, Rep. Rotondi of Athens, and Sen. Summers of Cumberland. Appropriations & Financial Affairs. OTP-AM Accepted 03/16/92. Amended by: CA H-1102. Finally Passed, CON RES LAWS, Chapter 4. Final Disposition: Approved in Referendum 11/03/92 (In favor: 467,672; Opposed: 164,759).
