An Act to Reform Financing of Referendum Questions. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27.) Presented by Representative MORRISON of Bangor; Cosponsored by Representatives: ADAMS of Portland, CASHMAN of Old Town, CLARK of Millinocket, DONNELLY of Presque Isle, ERWIN of Rumford, GEAN of Alfred, GOULD of Greenville. GWADOSKY of Fairfield, HICHBORN of LaGrange, JACQUES of Waterville, JOSEPH of Waterville, KONTOS of Windham, MARTIN of Eagle Lake, PARADIS of Augusta, POULIOT of Lewiston, SULLIVAN of Bangor, Senators: HANDY of Androscoggin, VOSE of Washington.
