An Act to Require Labeling on Genetically Engineered Food. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27.) Presented by Senator TITCOMB of Cumberland; Cosponsored by Representative HEESCHEN of Wilton and Senators: CAHILL of Sagadahoc, McCORMICK of Kennebec, PEARSON of Penobscot, WEBSTER of Franklin, Representatives: AULT of Wayne, CHASE of China, JACQUES of Waterville, KILKELLY of Wiscasset, KUTASI of Bridgton, MARSHALL of Eliot, NASH of Camden, SPEAR of Nobleboro, TARDY of Palmyra.
