An Act to Seek Congressional Term Limits. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 03/19/96. ONTP Accepted Pursuant to Joint Rule 15 03/22/96. Final Disposition: Approved in Referendum 11/05/96 (In favor: 318,119; Opposed: 225,620), INITIATED BILL, Chapter 2. [This initiated bill was ruled unconstitutional: League of Women Voters of Maine v. Gwadosky, 966 F. Supp. 52 (D. Me. 1997).]
