An Act to Promote Competition in the State's Liquor Industry. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Senator DAGGETT of Kennebec; Cosponsored by Representative BUCK of Yarmouth. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 01/20/98. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/11/98.
