An Act to Reimburse Kennebec County for the Costs of County Jail Construction. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Senator TREAT of Kennebec; Cosponsored by Representative POULIN of Oakland. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Public Hearing 02/12/98. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 03/11/98.
