An Act to Apply ERISA Standards to Pension Benefits for Teachers and State Employees to Clarify that They Are Nonforfeitable Once Accrued. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Senator MILLS of Somerset. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Labor. Public Hearing 01/27/98. Final Disposition: Majority (ONTP) Accepted 03/30/98.
