An Act to Amend Road Signs along I-95 and the Maine Turnpike to Indicate the Location of Full-service Gas Stations by Using the Handicap Access Symbol. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative DRISCOLL of Calais; Cosponsored by Senator O'GARA of Cumberland and Representatives: BOUFFARD of Lewiston, BUNKER of Kossuth Township, CHARTRAND of Rockland, FISHER of Brewer, SAVAGE of Union, WHEELER of Eliot, WINGLASS of Auburn, Senator CASSIDY of Washington. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. Public Hearing 02/04/98. Final Disposition: Ought Not to Pass Pursuant to Joint Rule 310 02/23/98.
