An Act to Make Public the Records of the Department of Corrections Relating to Inmate Furloughs and Requests under the Uniform Act for Out-of-State Parolee Supervision. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative JABAR of Waterville; Cosponsored by Senator MURRAY of Penobscot and Representatives: BUNKER of Kossuth Township, KERR of Old Orchard Beach, McALEVEY of Waterboro, MUSE of South Portland, POVICH of Ellsworth, THOMPSON of Naples, WATERHOUSE of Bridgton, WHEELER of Bridgewater.
