RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Amend the Timing of Elections Following the Submission of a Petition for People's Veto. Presented by Senator LONGLEY of Waldo; Cosponsored by Senators: HARRIMAN of Cumberland, PINGREE of Knox, RAND of Cumberland, Representatives: MAYO of Bath, TOWNSEND of Portland, PERKINS of Penobscot, PINKHAM of Lamoine, ROSEN of Bucksport, STANWOOD of Southwest Harbor. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 02/23/99. OTP-AM Accepted 03/30/99. Amended by: CA S-24. Finally Passed, CON RES LAWS, Chapter 1. Final Disposition: Approved in Referendum 11/02/99 (In favor: 285,174; Opposed: 114,640).
