(Submitted by the Department of Transportation pursuant to Joint Rule 204.) Presented by Senator SAVAGE of Knox. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. Public Hearing 01/23/02. OTP-AM Accepted 02/26/02. Amended by: CA S-419, HA/CA H-842. Finally Passed, CON RES LAWS, Chapter 1. Final Disposition: Approved by Referendum 11/05/02 (In favor: 262,900; Opposed: 212,940)
