An Act To Encourage Voluntary Efficiency in Maine's School Systems and Related Costs Savings. (GOVERNOR'S BILL). Presented by Representative McLAUGHLIN of Cape Elizabeth; Cosponsored by Senator DAMON of Hancock and Representatives: BOWEN of Rockport, CUMMINGS of Portland, MILLS of Cornville, Senators: DOUGLASS of Androscoggin, MITCHELL of Penobscot. Referred to Joint Select Committee on Regionalization and Community Cooperation. Public Hearing 03/17/04. House: Minority (ONTP) Accepted 04/16/04. Senate: Engrossment Failed 04/28/04. Final Disposition: Died in Concurrence 04/28/04.
