LD 1928 / HP1428

An Act To Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$4,822,368 To Provide Funds To Repair and Upgrade Maine Army National Guard Armories and Facilities and for the Challenger Learning Center of Maine. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.) Presented by Representative HATCH of Skowhegan; Cosponsored by Senator HATCH of Somerset and Representatives: BENNETT of Caribou, COLWELL of Gardiner, FISCHER of Presque Isle, MAILHOT of Lewiston, PERRY of Bangor, TARDY of Newport, Senators: MARTIN of Aroostook, MAYO of Sagadahoc, STANLEY of Penobscot, WESTON of Waldo.
