Standing Comm. on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 02/18/10. Majority (OTP-AM) Accepted 04/07/10. Amended by: HA H-831. Final Disposition: Finally Passed, Signed 04/14/10, RESOLVE LAWS, Chapter 212.
