An Act To Allow Sunday Hunting North of U.S. Route 2 from the New Hampshire Border to Bangor, North of Route 9 from Bangor to the Canadian Border and within That Portion of the White Mountain National Forest inside the State. Presented by Representative ORDWAY of Standish. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Public Hearing 04/21/21. Final Disposition: Accepted Majority (ONTP) Report 06/03/21.
