(Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative HYMANSON of York. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services. Public Hearing 02/22/22. Majority (OTP-AM) Report Accepted 04/12/22. Amended by: CA (Changed Title) H-970. Final Disposition: Died On Adjournment 05/09/22.
