An Act To Support Law Enforcement Officers, Corrections Officers, E-9-1-1 Dispatchers, Firefighters and Emergency Medical Services Persons Diagnosed with Post-traumatic Stress Disorder. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative SYLVESTER of Portland. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Labor and Housing. Public Hearing 01/31/22. OTP-AM Accepted 04/05/22. Amended by: CA H-888. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 04/18/22, PUBLIC LAW, Chapter 629.
