An Act To Prevent the Use of Prone and Supine Restraints, Chemical Sprays and Electroshock Devices on Juveniles Held in Department of Corrections Facilities. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 203.) Presented by Representative LOOKNER of Portland. Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety. Public Hearing 02/11/22. Final Disposition: Died On Adjournment 05/09/22.
